## SOCCER PREVIEW



Ten thrilling matches are set to take place at John Crain Field in the OU Soccer Complex this season. Fans can count on plenty of entertainment every weekend this fall. Oklahoma is set to face seven returning NCAA Tournament teams, including 2013 defending NCAA runner-up Florida State. OU also will take on tournament participants Oklahoma State, Utah, Florida, Nebraska, Texas Tech and West Virginia throughout the fall. The home slate includes four of those teams.

The 10-game general admission season ticket package is \$40 for the public and \$32 for faculty and staff, letterwinners, youth and senior citizens.

Head coach Matt Potter and the Oklahoma soccer team announced the addition of junior transfer Laura Rayfield to the roster for the 2014 fall season. Rayfield joins OU after two seasons as a defender at Oregon State. Rayfield and was named a Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention. Single-match tickets will go on sale beginning Aug. 13. Discounted ticket packages are available for groups of 10 or more.
